

# Yankee Doodle Dandy

## Colors

- Red - Medium to Dark Red Print, Tone on Tone or Red and White print that reads as Red
- White - Solid, or White on White
- Blue - Medium to Dark Blue Print, Tone on Tone or RWB print that reads as Blue

## Cutting Instructions for 1 block

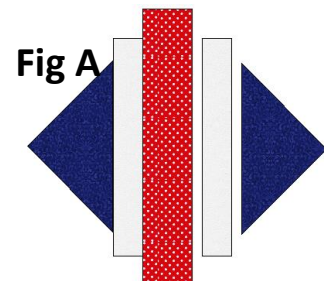
Red	(1) 3" by 14" Strip
White	(2) 2" by 11" Strips
Blue	(1) 6" Square

1. Fold all strips in half, end to end, and press or mark the center. This is your center matching point for all strips.
2. Sew a White strip to one side of the 14" Red strip, matching the centers. Repeat with the other White strip **FIG A**. Press to the Red.
3. Cut the Blue 6" square in half diagonally.
4. Fold the Blue Triangles in half on the long side and press or mark the center. Sew the Blue Triangles to the White strips matching the center marks **FIG A**. Press to the Blue.
5. **Use an 8 ½" or larger square ruler with a diagonal line to trim the block to 8 ½".**

Lay the block on the cutting mat as in **Fig B** with the diagonal line of the ruler down the center of the Red strip and the 1" ruler corner at the top right.

Check the 8 ½" marks on the left and bottom edges to ensure you will have room to trim the other sides, then trim the top and right side of the block.

6. Rotate the block 180 degrees **Fig C**. Line up the 8 ½" ruler lines with the trimmed edges and trim the remaining two sides.



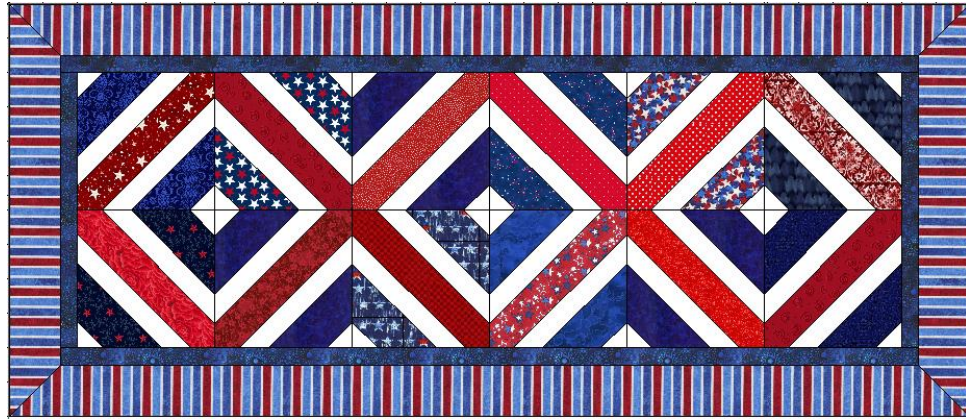

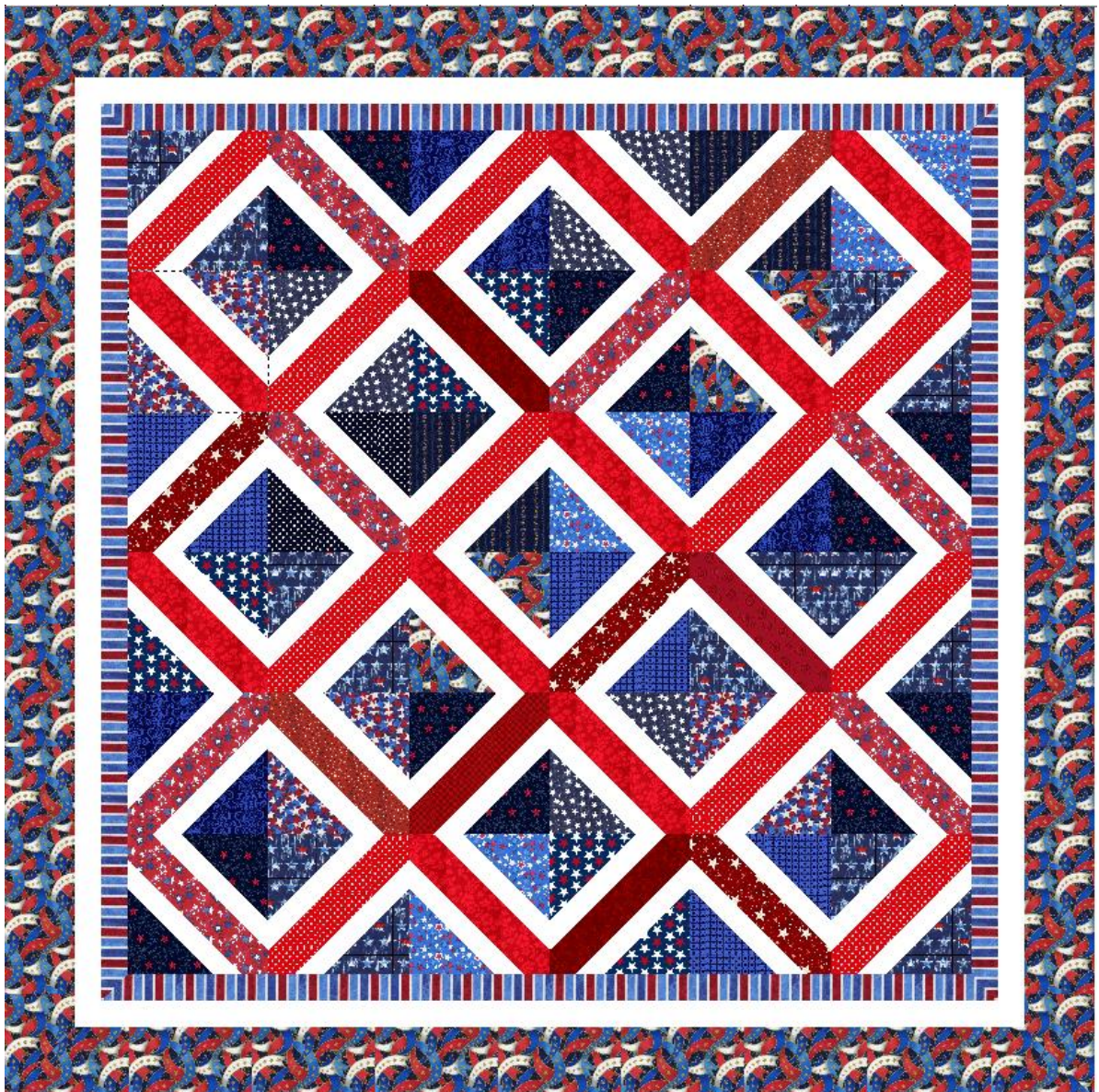
