## New Year's Star

## Colors

Background - White or White on White fabrics.
Star Blades - A Stripe in any colors you like.
Color Corners - A Tone on Tone, Solid or Print that reads as one color in a color that coordinates with your Striped fabric.

## Cutting Instructions - $81 / 2$ " square unfinished Block

## Background

(4) $2^{1 / 2 / 2}$ squares
(4) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

## Star Stripe

(4) $21 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles - VIP: Stripe runs crosswise Color Corners
(4) $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 2^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares

1. Background Units - Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Accent Color squares. Match a Color square to one end of each $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ White rectangle as shown in Fig 1. VIP - The Direction of the line does matter. Sew on the drawn line. Press the seam allowance toward the color corner then trim the seam allowance to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Make 4
2. Stripe Units - Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ White squares. Match a White square to one end of each $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Striped rectangle as shown in Fig 2. VIP - The Direction of the line does matter. Press the seam allowance toward the Stripe rectangle then trim the seam allowance to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Make 4
3. Match each Stripe Unit to a Background Unit as in Fig3. Sew and Press the seams open
4. Sew the four sections together pressing all seams open.
